- Olivia Broome for her sporting success in representing Great Britain. Olivia won the gold medal in the Junior Women's 50kg event at the 2021 World Para Powerlifting Championships and the silver medal in the senior women's 50kg event, and that
- The Stephen Higgins Young Citizen Award is to Elouisa Porter who has challenged herself to complete 24 litter picks as the charity element of the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Elouisa has used it as a way to challenge others through social media to stop dropping litter and to look after their local environment.
