## YOU SAID WE DID.....

**You Said ...** We are concerned about the planning of an Anaerobic Digester Unit on land within the Adlington Boundary

**We ...** Held an Open Forum at the last Adlington Town Council Meeting at which residents were allowed and encouraged to give their views and also allowed to remain in the meeting while the planning was discussed as an agenda item.

Since then, we have compiled a lengthy return to Lancashire County Council Planning department as we are consultees like the residents, we have included issues raised at the open forum. It became apparent at that meeting that many residents did not understand our role within the planning process and with that in mind please see below a quick synopsis.

**You said ...** We would like to know what role Adlington Town Council play in the Planning Permission Process -

### The Planning Process

The planning permission system is complex involving strategic plans, regulation, and law however the town council's part within it is to advise the decision makers. Planning applications are submitted to Chorley Council who prior to a making any decision undertake a formal consultation of neighbours and other stakeholders.

As part of this process the town council are asked to formally submit comments on applications.

Applications to be discussed by the town council are published on the agenda, and members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting to make representations.

The town council's comments on applications are agreed by the council at the monthly meeting and are the considered response of the whole council (not any individual Councillor), who aim to represent the best interests of the community.

These comments are taken into consideration by borough council officers or, or the planning committee of CBC if the application is a significant development or by Lancashire County Council as in this case.

After considering all submitted comments (and considering all the strategic and legal issues) they make the decision as to whether planning permission is granted.
